



Every drop of water on the planet is precious. Fresh water is crucial for drinking, washing and growing food. But the increasing population may push the planet towards a thirstier future. It has been predicted that by 2050, half of the World's population may no longer have safe drinking water. To manage competing demands for freshwater we should work with nature rather than against it.

A household water audit is an assessment of how much water is used and how much water can be saved at home.

Conducting a water audit involves calculating water use and identifying simple ways for saving water in the home.


