Activity 1: Rhyming Word Challenge

Materials Needed: Chart paper or notebook, crayons, and glue (optional)

Instructions to the Learner:

1. Say these words aloud: **cat, fig, sun, box, jug, hat, fun, fox, mug, and dig.**
2. Now match the words that sound the same:
(cat – hat), (sun – fun), (box – fox)
3. Draw or paste a small picture for each rhyming pair.
4. Colour your pictures and say the pairs aloud with a smile!
5. **This activity should be done with a parent's guidance.**





Activity 2: Shape House Project

Materials Needed:

Coloured paper, scissors, glue, crayons, and a sheet of chart or notebook paper

Instructions to the Learner:

1. Cut out different shapes: **triangle** for the roof, **square** for the wall, **circle** for windows, and **rectangle** for the door.
2. Paste the shapes to build your own house on paper.
3. Colour your house nicely and label the shapes used.
4. Draw a table where count of the individual shapes are mentioned.

Activity 3: Family Tree Craft

Materials Needed: Chart paper or notebook, crayons, glue, scissors, and printed or hand-drawn pictures of family members

Instructions to the Learner:

1. Draw a **tree** with big branches on a chart paper and colour it.
2. Paste or draw **pictures of your family members** on the branches (like parents, siblings, grandparents).
3. Write their names below the picture.
4. Decorate the tree with leaves, flowers, or hearts.
5. **This activity should be done with a parent's guidance.**

Week 2

Activity 4: Letter Craft

Materials Needed: Chart paper or A4 sheet, coloured paper, glue, scissors, crayons

Instructions to the Learner:

1. Use two different coloured paper to cut consonant and vowel letters. Learners need to cut both **capital and small form** of the letter (e.g., A and a) from Aa to Zz.
2. Paste the letters on the chart paper. Learners ensure you have space to draw or paste pictures of two things that begin with that letter (e.g., A for apple, ant).
3. Decorate around them as you like.
4. Learners will hold the chart paper and say the letter sound and the object name aloud.
5. **This activity should be done with a parent's guidance.**



Activity 5: Measuring Fun

Materials Needed: Building blocks / spoons / pencils / paper clips, a small notebook or A4 sheet, pencil

Instructions to the Learner:

1. Choose any object in your house (like a book or your water bottle).
2. Measure it using building blocks or paper clips placed end-to-end.
3. Count how many it takes to match the length.
4. Draw the object and write the number of blocks or clips it measured.
5. Parents take the picture of the activity and paste it in the notebook.
6. This activity should be done with a parent's guidance.

Activity 6: How We Travel

Materials Needed: Pictures of vehicles (from magazines or drawings), glue, A4 sheet, pencil, crayons

Instructions to the Learner:

1. Look at pictures of different vehicles from old books or magazines (bus, car, train, boat, airplane, bicycle, etc.).
2. Sort them into **land**, **water**, and **air** transport.
3. Take an A4 size sheet. Divide the paper in three sections, one each for three modes of transport (**land**, **water**, and **air**).
4. Paste or draw at least two for each type in the individual sections.
5. Colour them and label the type of transport.
6. On another A4 sheet, paste pictures of one vehicle which works on both air-land, water-air, and water-land. Parents help the learner to research.
7. **This activity should be done with a parent's guidance.**

Week 3

Activity 7: Rainbow Writing-Letter.

Materials Needed: Worksheet with dotted capital and small letters, pencil, eraser, crayons.

Instructions to the Learner:

1. Trace the dotted letters on the worksheet.
2. Try writing each letter independently in the below boxes.
3. Use different crayon colours trace for fun and make it colourful.
4. Say each letter's name and sound as you write.
5. This activity should be done a parent's guidance.


Activity 8: Jumping by Twos!

Materials Needed: Chart paper or floor tiles marked by chalk, Number cards (1,2,3 4.....10)

Instructions to the Learner:

1. Lay number cards or write numbers in a line on the floor.
2. Start at 2 and jump on each number while saying it aloud.
3. Parents can guide and cheer as you jump.

4. You can also clap or tap as you skip count.
 5. After jumping, create the skip counting tiles on the chart paper.
 6. This activity should be done with a parent's guidance.

Activity 9: Harvest Festival Collage

Materials Needed: Old magazines/newspapers, glue, chart paper, scissors (to be used by parent), crayons

Instructions to the learner:

1. With your parent, find and cut out pictures of harvest festivals like Pongal, Baisakhi, Makar Sankranti, and Onam.
2. Paste them on chart paper to make a colourful collage.
3. Draw a sun or crops to decorate.
4. Ask your parent to help you name each festival.
5. *This activity should be done with a parent's guidance.*
