■ **गद्यांश:**

“मुंशी प्रेमचंद हिंदी साहित्य के महान लेखक थे। उनका जन्म 31 जुलाई 1880 को उत्तर प्रदेश के वाराणसी के पास एक छोटे से गाँव में हुआ था। उनका असली नाम धनपत राय श्रीवास्तव था, लेकिन वे प्रेमचंद के नाम से प्रसिद्ध हुए। उन्होंने अपने जीवन में अनेक कठिनाइयों का सामना किया, फिर भी उन्होंने लेखन कार्य को नहीं छोड़ा।

प्रेमचंद जी ने अपनी कहानियों और उपन्यासों के माध्यम से समाज की सच्चाई को उजागर किया। उनकी रचनाओं में गरीबों, किसानों और मजदूरों की समस्याओं का बहुत ही सरल और प्रभावशाली वर्णन मिलता है। उनकी भाषा बहुत सरल और सहज थी, जिसे हर वर्ग का व्यक्ति आसानी से समझ सकता था।

उनकी प्रसिद्ध रचनाओं में ‘गोदान’, ‘गबन’ और ‘ईदगाह’ शामिल हैं। ‘ईदगाह’ कहानी में उन्होंने एक छोटे बच्चे हामिद के त्याग और प्रेम को बहुत ही सुंदर ढंग से प्रस्तुत किया है। प्रेमचंद जी का मानना था कि साहित्य समाज का दर्पण होता है।

आज भी उनकी रचनाएँ हमें सच्चाई, ईमानदारी और मानवता का पाठ पढ़ाती हैं। वे हिंदी साहित्य के एक अमूल्य रत्न थे और हमेशा याद किए जाएंगे।”
